REPORTS AND STUDIES OF MECHANISMS AND MANDATES

The Human Rights Council,

- OP.1. Recalls its decisions 2006/102, 2006/104 and 2006/105;
- *OP.2. Notes* all the reports and studies presented at its second session and the **substantive** inter active dialogue with mandate holders as well as with the High Commissioner for Human Rights*;
- OP.3. Requests the Secretary-General, the High-Commissioner for Human Rights, the Office of the High Commissioner for Human Rights and the Secretariat to continue with the fulfilment of their activities, in accordance with all previous resolutions, decisions and Chairperson's statements adopted by the Commission on Human Rights and to update the relevant reports and studies;

OP.4. Decides:

- (i) to transmit the views of the Sub-Commission on Promotion and Protection of Human Rights on the Human Rights Council's future system of expert advice to the Working Group established pursuant to Human Rights Council decision 2006/104;
- (ii) to take note the draft decisions transmitted by the Sub-Commission pertaining to previously authorized activities, with a view to allowing their continuation in accordance with Council's decision 2006/102.
- *OP.5. Notes* the updates provided on the progress of the informal consultations on the universal periodic review established by its decision 2006/103 and on implementation of paragraph 6 of General Assembly resolution 60/251 established by its decision 2006/104.
