However, The Mission's concern about the procedure is still sustained, and it's our full conviction that, had the list of candidates included a reasonable number, it would have enabled you and the Council to agree on undisputed candidate who is acceptable to all parties.

Furthermore, The Mission of Sudan would like to seize this opportunity to repeat its previous request for reopening the procedure of announcement for the vacancy due to the reasons mentioned above.
